## **SLANSW Teacher Librarian of the Year Award**

SLANSW Teacher Librarian of the Year is awarded to a teacher librarian or team of teacher librarians in recognition of their outstanding contribution to teaching and learning in their school and their engagement with the school library community.

### **The successful candidate/s will:**

- Be employed as a teacher librarian in a NSW school.
- Hold formal qualifications in school librarianship and classroom teaching as defined by the [ALIA/ASLA Statement on Teacher Librarian Qualifications \(July 2016\)](#).
- Be nominated by a member of their school community and supported by a member of the school leadership team.
- Provide evidence of outstanding practice based on key areas in the [ALIA/ASLA Standards of Professional Excellence for Teacher Librarians](#).
- Provide evidence of engagement with their school library community.

### **Submission of nominations**

- The nominee must be a personal member of SLANSW or a nominated representative of an institutional member.
- The nominee must be endorsed on the award application by a SLANSW member.
- Nomination forms with supporting documentation must be emailed to the Secretary [info@slansw.net.au](mailto:info@slansw.net.au) by 5.00pm, Friday 26th November 2021
- Nominations will be considered by the SLANSW Awards Panel for recommendation to the SLANSW Committee.

### **Announcement of Award**

- The SLANSW Teacher Librarian of the Year for 2021 will be announced and conferred at the SLANSW Conference on 19th March 2022.
- The SLANSW Committee reserves the right not to confer this award in any year.
