The John H Lee Memorial Award

The John H Lee Memorial Award is presented to an individual or a school team in recognition of innovation in learning and teaching practice in a school or schools through learning technologies.

The successful candidate/s will:

- Clearly identify the area/s, field/s or aspect/s of practice leading to innovation in learning and teaching practice through learning technologies in a school or schools.
- Provide evidence of excellence in leadership in the design, use, and/or integration of learning technologies into teaching and learning.
- Demonstrate that the leadership addresses teaching practice, is collaborative in design or implementation, and has the potential to address student learning outcomes.
- Demonstrate how innovation in learning and teaching practice meets one or more of the [Association's objectives](#).

Any demonstration of innovative teaching practice must have occurred within the **two years** prior to the award being conferred.

Submission of nominations

- This award may be peer or self-nominated.
- The nominee can be an individual or a school team.
- The nominee must hold financial (personal or institutional) or life membership for at least 12 months prior to the closing date for applications.
- Self-nominated applicants need to provide a supporting statement of endorsement from a SLANSW member.
- Nomination forms with supporting documentation must be emailed to the Secretary info@slansw.net.au by 5.00pm, Friday 25th November 2022.
- Nominations will be considered by the SLANSW Awards Panel for recommendation to the SLANSW Committee.

Announcement of Award

The John H Lee Memorial Award for 2022 will be announced and conferred at the SLANSW Conference in March 2023.

The SLANSW Committee reserves the right not to confer this award in any year.
