

SLANSW Teacher Librarian of the Year Award

SLANSW Teacher Librarian of the Year is awarded to a teacher librarian or team of teacher librarians in recognition of their outstanding contribution to teaching and learning in their school and their engagement with the wider school library community.

The successful candidate/s will:

- Be employed as a teacher librarian in a NSW school.
- Hold formal qualifications in school librarianship and classroom teaching as defined by the ALIA/ASLA Statement on Teacher Librarian Qualifications (July 2016).
- Be nominated by a member of their school community and supported by a member of the school leadership team.
- Provide evidence of outstanding practice based on key areas in the <u>ALIA/ASLA Standards of Professional Excellence for Teacher Librarians</u>.
- Provide evidence of engagement with the wider school library community.

Submission of nominations

- Nominees must have held a personal membership or have been a nominated representative of an institutional membership of SLANSW for a minimum of 12 months at the close of nominations.
- The nominee must be endorsed on the award application by a SLANSW member.
- Nomination forms with supporting documentation must be emailed to the Executive Officer at info@slansw.net.au by 5.00pm, Friday 24th November 2023.
- Nominations will be considered by the SLANSW Awards Panel for recommendation to the SLANSW Committee.

Announcement of Award

- The award for the 2024 SLANSW Teacher Librarian of the Year will be announced and conferred at the March 2024 SLANSW Summit.
- The SLANSW Committee reserves the right not to confer this award in any year.
