



SLANSW Life Membership

Life Membership of SLANSW is a prestigious award and is bestowed on members who have demonstrated sustained commitment to improving the Association and its mission through their voluntary work for the association.

Life Membership is not considered a competitive award and nominees must be considered individually and not in comparison with others. Each nomination is judged on its merits against the guiding criteria and there should be no limit in any one year on the number of members who might be awarded Life Membership.

Criteria for Life Membership

The nominee must:

- be a financial member of SLANSW,
- have shown long-term commitment to the Association and its objectives, and
- have contributed significantly to the core activities of the Association by holding a position as Office-Bearer for the Association and/or participating in its activities to a greater extent than the average SLANSW member.

Nominations for Life Membership

A nominator must be a financial member of the Association and the following information should be included in a nomination for Life Membership:

- any relevant current and previous professional positions held by the nominee,
- any relevant examples of the nominee's outstanding service (awards, publications etc.),
- any other relevant information that supports the nomination,
- a statement from the nominator as to why they support the nomination, and
- a second reference supporting the nomination.

Life Membership will be granted by a two-thirds majority vote of Management Committee members who are present at the meeting where the nomination is considered.
