

Role Statement: Ordinary Committee Member

Each member of the committee may hold office for a period of 2 years from the annual general meeting at which they were elected, and is eligible for re-election.

Ordinary Members of the Committee will:

- 1. Uphold the values, mission, and objectives of the Association.
- 2. Abide by the guidelines for members outlined in the SLANSW Constitution or any other document relevant to the strategic and/or operational management of the Association.
- 3. Support the office-bearers (the Executive) in managing the affairs of the Association.
- 4. Attend meetings of the Management Committee (1-2 per term) and actively participate in decision-making on matters raised.
- 5. Contribute to the leadership of the Association by actively participating in at least one sub-committee or hold an appointed role, and be encouraged to support special interest or project groups.
- 6. Assist with the Association's major professional learning events. Such assistance may be provided in the planning, delivery, or post phase of the event.
- 7. Contribute to publications (e.g., newsletter) by means of articles, reports, or reflections on topics of interest or professional learning experiences.
- 8. Participate in the promotion of the Association via preferred social media platforms or pdf distribution.
